What makes this line particularly compelling is its potency. Replere is formulated with more than 70% antioxidants—one of the highest concentrations on the market—thanks to a patented lab process that preserves and delivers these active ingredients at their peak. And the results speak for themselves: A 12-week, double-blind, randomized, controlled clinical study found that participants using Replere experienced visible improvement in firmness, hyperpigmentation, blotchy redness, fine lines, wrinkles, and overall skin brightness. The findings were significant enough to be published in the Journal of Drugs in Dermatology.

A Unique Delivery System

Beyond the formulation, the delivery system is equally thoughtful. All Replere products come in airless packaging, which helps protect the integrity of the antioxidants. "Think of a sliced apple turning brown," Dr. Palmer explains. "That's oxidation. The same thing happens to active ingredients when exposed to air." The airless pump not only prevents contamination but also dispenses the perfect amount of product every time—no waste, no guesswork.

Among the hero ingredients in the line: Coffea arabica (the un-ripened berry of the coffee plant), known for its high antioxidant content; green tea, with its anti-inflammatory properties; and hyaluronic acid, which draws moisture into the skin. Replere's Day Lotion acts like a daily shield, protecting skin from environmental stressors like pollution and UV exposure. The Night Crème works as a recovery treatment, helping to rebuild collagen and repair skin overnight. Combined, they deliver both immediate hydration and long-term restoration.
